Human being are the highest level animals, in accordance with a high-level thinking skill, advanced language skills and advanced ability to change the world. Low-level animals behaviors are spontaneous, lacking of self-consciousness, does not have the ability of the learning and combination of linguistic symbols. Animals, through the movements of their bodies and sound, communicate with human being or other animals. There is no reason to deny that animals also have consciousness.

Consciousness can react to the matter. Purposeful activities of animals are conscious reaction to the matter world. Consciousness can rearrange matter to produce new functions, but can not create matter.

It can be verified from different ways to understand that consciousness is an advanced and organized form of matter.

No matter to the human being with advanced developed brain, or to the lower animals do not have the brain, and even to the robots which have some intelligence, this high-level and organized form of matter are widespread. The statements above can be explained as follows.

In the human brain, the formation of people's consciousness is a process of reflection to the different signals from the outside. The strong signal in people's mind can be detected, combining with people's different behavioral responses, which can be used to detect people's consciousness activities. For example: polygraph is based on the invention of this theory, within a certain range can be used. It has been proved scientific and rational.

Lower animals do not have the advanced brain and can not produce signals to control the activities of other parts of the body, but they can play the same role which is similar to the role of the brain, and thus they can control their activities in a certain level, corresponding to external stimuli. The behavior that functions as the brain, but not through the brain, can be called low-level consciousness.
